




INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN THE UNITED STATES 1949/50-2019/20

TOP 10 PLACES OF ORIGIN FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS




1-YEAR CHANGE IN LEADING PLACES OF ORIGIN OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
