




International scholar appointments and applications affected by COVID-19 pandemic



International Scholars in the United States





International Scholars by Place of Origin





Leading Places of Origin







Leading Specializations of International Scholars




81% of international scholars focused their academic activities in STEM fields.



Duration of International Scholar Appointments





Impacts institutions faced related to international scholars






Fully or partially closed facilities

Freezing new scholar appointments or applications






