













IEP Enrollments by State




IEP Top Places of Origin in 2021




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Average IEP Weeks per Student


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In 2021, **32%** of IEP students intend to continue further (non-IEP) study in the United States.

Average IEP Weeks by Institutional Type





IEP Enrollment as a Percent of All International Students




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
Enrollment Trends by Percent Change
