




# International Students by Field of Study






# Fields of Study by Academic Level










# Strong Growth for Undergraduate and OPT

- **Short-term** 8 weeks or less during the academic year or summer
- **Mid-Length** One/two quarters or semester
- Long-term Academic year or calendar year





#### **U.S. Study Abroad, 2022/23**




#### U.S. Higher Education, Fall 2022\*




### International Students: Proportion of Total Enrollment
