



Leading Places of Origin of International Scholars






International Scholars by World Region of Origin







Leading Places of Origin All-Time Highs

































Primary Function of International Scholars






Primary Function by Type of Institution










78% of international scholars focused their academic activities in STEM fields.




Duration of International Scholar Appointments






